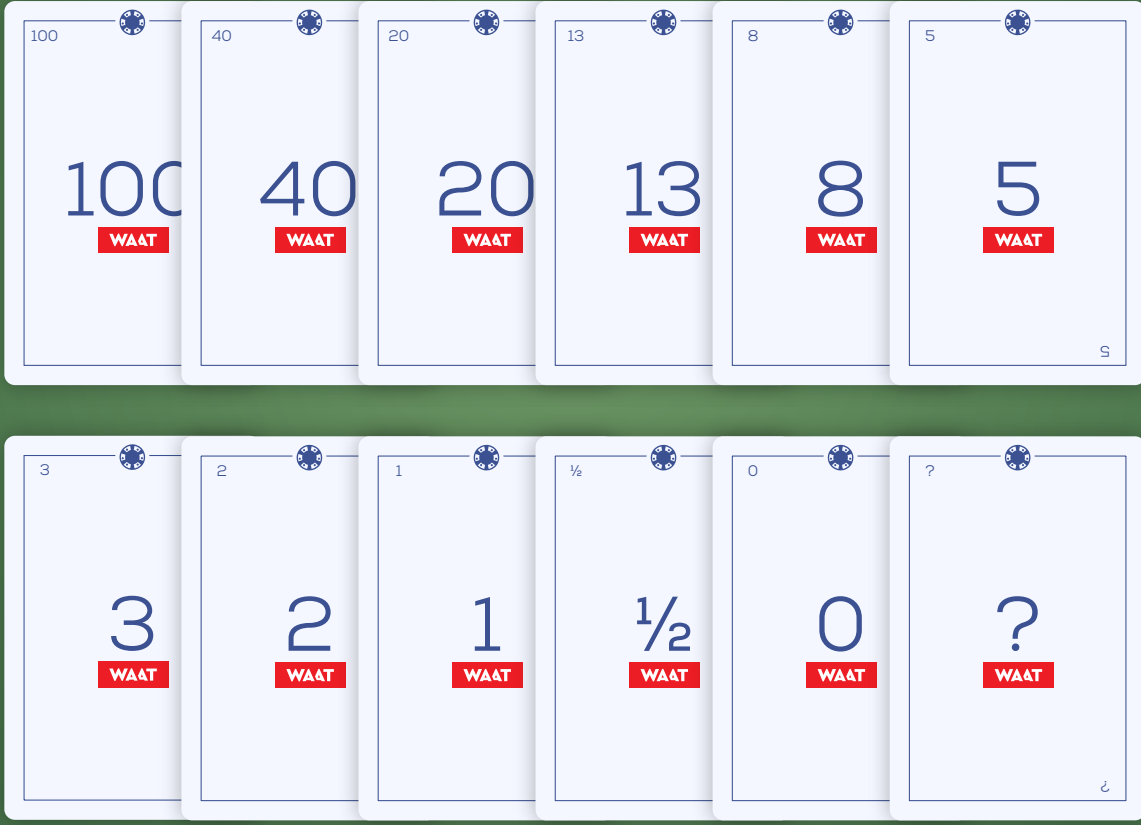


How it works

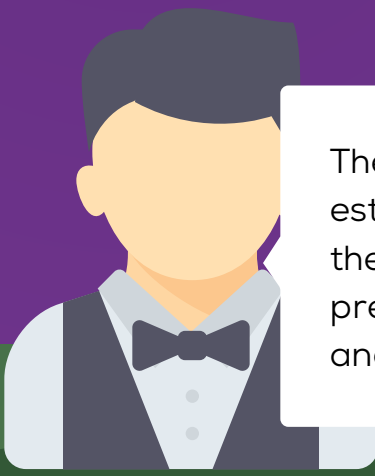
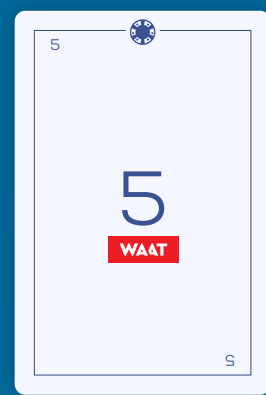
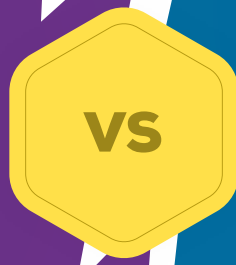
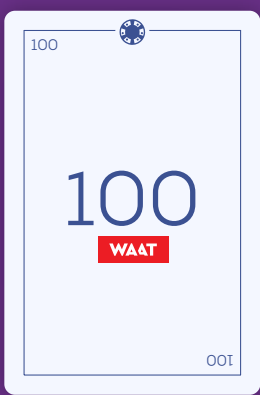
Each player is given a pack of cards with the values 0, 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 13, 20, 40 and 100. The values represent the number of points they would give to a particular task, with 0 being no time or resources required at all to 100 being maximum time or resources.



The product owner describes the task, feature or agile user story.



Each player then makes an estimation of the work involved by revealing the card they would give to the task.



The persons with the highest and lowest estimates then explain to the group why they selected those values. After their presentations, all the players make another estimation by revealing a card.



This process is repeated until a consensus is reached on the estimation of the task.
